Gascoyne has used the charrette process for many years to achieve meaningful community engagement. In September 2025, we hosted two workshops at Cuffley Camp focussed on the Estate's role in generating green electricity.

These events explored a variety of themes associated with renewable energy development, including landscape impact, food security and community benefit.

We committed to undertaking independent landscape assessments of all the land discussed in September - at South Mimms, Newgate Street and Essendon - and reviewing the results with the community in early 2026. The assessments have been completed, and the findings will be available at the drop-in session.

As a reminder, we do not currently have a definitive scheme in mind. No agreements have been signed, and no commitments have been made. The purpose of this event is to gather your feedback on the implications for landscape, so that any scheme that does come forward is properly considered.

We look forward to welcoming you on the 26th February to see the results of this work, and discuss next steps with the Gascoyne team.
